“Nature Group expands seagoing waste collection fleet”

Nature Group PLC (AIM: NGR), is glad to announce that it has finalized the purchase, out of existing reserves, of seagoing tanker MT “Crystalwater”. With the addition of the “Crystalwater”, Nature will operate a fleet of four seagoing vessels for offshore waste collection and disposal services in the Mediterranean.

Andreas Drenthen the CEO of Nature commented, “The 2,683 DWT (deadweight) Crystalwater will have an important role in achieving our growth in the region and support the companies further development in respect to quality, safety and further expansion of our global maritime waste collection and disposal services”. The IMO II, Lloyds classified and combined chemical/oil tanker has a LOA (length overall) of 80.00 mtr, maximum draught of 5.10 mtr and 12 stainless steel tanks including two deck tanks with an overall intake capacity of over 2,500 Metric ton. Its stainless steel and number of tanks makes the ship flexible and ideal for the collection of both large “full cargo” parcels and small chemical parcels which require separate collection, storage and treatment.

Nature Group’s waste collection fleet strengthened with the “Crystalwater” emphasizes the companies unique CSR strategy and focus on Clean Seas. Additionally, Nature Group has the ambition to be at the forefront in its business fields in order to contribute to a planet with cleaner seas and maximum transparency in the waste collection and disposal chain.
